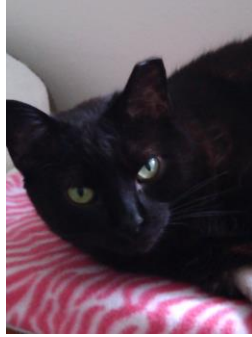


## CAT GUARDIANS URGENTLY NEEDS YOUR HELP!



Recently several cats and kittens have been abandoned at our shelter. Many of these abandoned cats and kittens have needed comprehensive medical care well above and beyond the usual spay/neuter and inoculations.

We have some of our own kitties who need extra special help too. Sonya has cancer in her bone marrow and after three transfusions and two hospital stays; she is doing much better and recently started chemotherapy. Our costs for Sonya are already over \$5000. We also have Séamus and Robbie who are in kidney failure and require fluid therapy. Both Beanie Baby and Billy Boy are diabetic and require daily insulin, and we have several other cats that require special medical care.



Many other shelters would simply euthanize these cats because the medical care is just too expensive. Unlike these other shelters, Cat Guardians makes **medical decisions based solely on what is in the best interest of the cat, regardless of the monetary cost.**

Right now our vet costs are staggering (even with discounted services from our vets). We need to raise money to help cover our medical costs.
